

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

KATY RICE BELT BASKETBALL OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION

GOOD STANDING REQUIREMENTS

The member must be a registered TASO Basketball Official.

All members must attend a minimum of 5 meetings, including the mandatory Coaches and Officials Meeting.

Officials must work a minimum of 1 scrimmage. The members must have taken and scored 70 and above on the state TASO Basketball tests.

The member must be up to date on all chapter dues, state dues, and assigning fees.

It is highly recommended that officials attend as many meetings as possible and work as many scrimmages as possible.

ADDITIONAL CREDIT FOR MEETING ATTENDANCE

An official that provides documentation that they attended an approved summer training camp will be given credit for one meeting to be in good standing.

An official that attends the state meeting and attends all sessions will be given credit for one meeting to be in good standing.

An official can only use one of these for a meeting attendance credit

The Katy Rice Belt Board may increase the number of credits for attendance at certain meetings

VARSITY GAME REQUIREMENTS

In order to be assigned a varsity game, you must also

- Attend the State Meeting,
- Attend a Regional Clinic, or
- Take the TASO online Training Clinic.
- State Test: Must score 80 or above on all tests (Rules, Two Person and Three Person)

POST SEASON REQUIREMENTS

MEET STATE REQUIREMENTS

- State Test: Must score 92 or above on all tests (Rules, Two Person and Three Person)
- Attend the State Meeting, Regional Clinic or take the TASO online Training Clinic.
- Assigning Fees: All assigning fees must be up to date before a playoff game may be assigned.

MEET CHAPTER REQUIREMENTS

- The official must attend a minimum of 50% of Katy Rice Belt Meetings.
- Work a minimum of 25 varsity contest, with at least 15 being varsity nights (excluding tournaments).
- Work a minimum of 2 JH nights to help train officials.
- Wear proper TASO approved uniform throughout the season— shoes, socks, referee pants (beltless), TASO logo shirt, and lanyard with a whistle. (Note When a jacket is worn for a varsity game, it must be the TASO jacket with colored logo. No non-TASO/SBOA jackets allowed.)
- Work a minimum of 2 scrimmages.
- **ATTEND AN APPROVED SUMMER TRAINING CAMP DURING THE LAST 4 YEARS**

Note: Just because you qualify for a Varsity or Playoff games, does not guarantee you will be assigned a Varsity or Playoff games.
